This is such an exciting time because students are really starting to read and recognize words on their own!!! During our Math Block, students will be working on patterns, measuring, and comparing. Remember, patterns can be found both inside and outside of the classroom, so be on the lookout this month! During Science, students will be learning about the four seasons of the year, and how to compare objects by size. A good story for reinforcing this objective is the classic, "Goldie Locks and The Three Bears".
